## **Questions for individual study and LIFE Groups:**

1. How does a person or a church come to a point where Jesus is no longer the focus of their life but merely an accessory? How would you describe the lifestyle of a person who is living with a “*cardboard Jesus*”?
2. What can we learn about Jesus Christ from the introduction of this letter?
3. How does Jesus really know people’s activities and their attitudes? Why is Jesus Christ concerned with the spiritual condition and deeds of the people who are part of His church?
4. What was happening in the church at Laodicea that Jesus was opposed to? Why is this a troubling state to the Lord of the church?
5. How would you define “*affluenza*”? What are some characteristics of someone with this condition? What happens to a church with many people living in this state?
6. What is Jesus’ counsel to people who do not delight in and depend upon Him?
7. How can we support and encourage each other in a way that will keep us from becoming like this church?
8. Why is it important that we seriously heed the warning of this letter to the church in Laodicea?
