## ***My personal application of this passage:***

### ***Questions for individual study and LIFE Groups:***

1. Which attributes of God bring you comfort when you find yourself troubled?
2. Recall and read a passage in the Old Testament that allows you to be reminded of the faithfulness of God. (Noah and the ark, Daniel and the lion's den, the story of Ruth, etc.).
3. Take verses 7-9 in Psalm 77 and answer Asaph's questions with scripture that speaks to God's faithfulness to never leave us nor forsake us.
4. Make a list of God's works of wonder found in scripture, then take time to meditate upon and praise Him for them.
5. How would you use God's faithfulness of the past to express your certainty of His faithfulness in the present and the future? For example, if you were in a gospel conversation how would God's faithfulness (past, present, future) be incorporated?
