The Ultimate Deception Unveiled

Revelation 13

What drives spiritual deception, and how far will it go in its final, ultimate expression?

The manifestation of an "unholy trinity" unveils Satan's ultimate deception:

13:1a 1.The devil: the enemy of God, "the dragon" who is Satan

And the great dragon was thrown down, the serpent of old who is called the devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

Revelation 12.9

2. The final false messiah: the antichrist who is "the beast from the 13:1b-10 sea"

3. The final false prophet: the unholy spirit who is "the beast from the earth" 13:11-18

But I am afraid that, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, your minds will be led astray from the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ.

2 Corinthians 11:3

What every person needs to overcome the deception of the devil:

- Deliverance through Christ
- **Devotion to Christ**
- Discernment from Christ
- Dedication to Christ's Great Commission (of making disciples of all the nations)

Apart from life in Christ, people become deceived and enslaved to the lies of the devil.

Questions for individual study and LIFE Groups:

1. Why do you think Satan presents the world a false messiah and false prophet during the final seven years before Christ's return to the earth?

2. Why do you think so many people in those last days will follow after this beast and worship the devil who empowers him (Rev. 13:3-4)? In what ways does Satan entice people to worship and follow after him today?

3. What is the only way a person can escape the devil's snare and not be held captive by him (Rev. 13:8-10)? What can we learn about the nature of salvation from these verses?

4. Why do you think God has revealed these details regarding this "unholy trinity" that will one day manifest itself upon the earth?

5. What role can Revelation 13 have in our life today, and what is needed to overcome the devil's deception?
