1. God redeems His people

14:1-5

### 2. God reveals His gospel

14:6-7

the gospel: the "good news" that by grace God forgives and redeems all who are broken over their sin, believe in the perfect life, substitutionary death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, and receive eternal life as a disciple in His kingdom

### 3. God renders judgment on His enemies

14:8-20

You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

## My personal application of this passage:

### Questions for individual study and LIFE Groups:

- 1. How are the redeemed in the tribulation described in Rev. 14:1-5? In what ways should those who are redeemed reflect the character of the Redeemer?
- 2. Why does God have His gospel proclaimed both today and in the end times before His Son's return?
- 3. Why does God bring about judgment upon those who reject Him?
- 4. What role does the gospel have in your life? How have you grown in understanding of the gospel and love for Christ in the past year?
- 5. Who is someone who does not truly know the Savior for whom you have been praying or with whom you have been seeking to share the love of Christ? How has our study of Revelation influenced your behavior in this regard?
