Acts 9

Comprehension

- 1. Saul before he professed Christ (1-2)
- 2. Saul's conversion in professing Christ (3-9)
- 3. Saul after he professed Christ (10-31)

Conviction

The eternal Gospel should stir up a passion within the believer to share the good news of Jesus at every opportunity.













Conduct

Put together a plan, practice the plan, put the plan into action!

My personal application of this passage:

Questions for individual study and LIFE Groups:

- 1. Who was Saul of Tarsus and what did we find him doing in the beginning of Acts 9?
- 2. How did Saul know to address the voice as Lord?
- 3. How do we protect ourselves against having the initial attitude of Ananias when we meet a new convert?
- 4. How did the eternal gospel change Saul? Spend time digging deep here. We know he was saved. How did his salvation change him into who he became?
- 5. Spend time crafting your personal plan to share the eternal gospel with others. Practice the plan and put it into action!
