My personal application of this passage:

Questions for individual study and LIFE Groups:

- 1. Have you ever had the experience of walking into the middle of a movie and not understanding what was happening on the screen? Why is it important that you know the beginning if you are going to make sense of the movie?
- 2. Why is it important that people understand the origins of Christmas?
- 3. What do we learn about the Word from John 1:1-18? How do we see the deity of the Word on display in these verses?
- 4. What is the amazing significance of John 1:14? What is the name of the eternal Word who has entered humanity (John 1:17)? When did you first understand the truth of these verses?
- 5. How could this passage bring you greater delight and devotion to Christ this Christmas season?
