My personal application of this passage:

Questions for individual study and LIFE Groups:

- 1. What did the disciples feel and discuss as they walked, and how does this mirror our responses to disappointment or unanswered prayers?
- 2. Why do you think the disciples didn't recognize Jesus initially, and what might keep us from recognizing His presence in our everyday lives?
- 3. As we see Jesus explaining the Scriptures to them before revealing Himself, what does this tell us about the role of God's word in personally knowing Him and building a deeper relationship with Him?
- 4. How does believing the Scripture and knowing the resurrected Son of God stir us to action and witness?
- 5. When did you believe in the resurrection of Jesus Christ? How does knowing that He is alive affect the way you live?
