Intentional Church: The Traits of a Church in Love with Christ

1 Timothy 6:1-2

Work: effort exerted in some purposeful activity. Work is a person's particular contribution to God's good world and to the common good.

How do believers in Christ manifest their relationship with Christ in the way they work?

How we manifest our relationship with Christ by the way we work:

1. Be respectful of those who have leadership responsibility 6:1a

2. Be purposeful to live out God's truth for His glory	6:1b

- 6. What small step can you take this week to reflect Christ more clearly in your work?
