3. How does God's word, especially 1 Timothy 5:1–2, guide us to relate differently to older men, younger men, older women, and younger women?
4. In practical terms, what does it mean to treat younger women “with all purity” as sisters? Why is this distinction important today?
5. How does knowing, experiencing, and expressing God's love serve as the foundation for healthy and holy relationships?
