Questions for individual study and LIFE Groups:

- 2. In what ways is wealth uncertain?
- 3. Do you know that God wants you to enjoy the material blessings He provides in this life? (Eccl. 5:18-19)
- 4. What does it look like to lead a generous life in all aspects your time, talent, treasure, and tribe?
- 5. How do you stay focused on the eternal rewards that await a generous life rather than getting caught up in the here-and-now?
- 6. What are next steps you can take to guard God's word and pursue a holy life that is pleasing to God?
- 7. Who in your life and sphere of influence can be your "O Timothy" relationship? How can you foster that relationship?
