#### My personal application of this passage:

# Questions for individual study, small group Bible studies, and LIFE Groups:

- 1. Who has God placed in your life to strengthen your relationship with Christ, and how might you express gratitude to God for them and encourage them this week?
- 2. How are you growing in your fellowship in the gospel, both in your personal relationship with Jesus Christ and with fellow believers, as emphasized in Philippians 1:5?
- 3. In what areas of your life do you need to renew your trust in God's ongoing work, and how does Philippians 1:6 give you confidence in Him and a joy in Christ?
- 4. Why is it important that believers grow in their ability to love others, as we see in Philippians 1:7-8? In what ways are you learning how to love like this?
- 5. Can you share a few ways you are growing in knowledge and discernment, and how this is expressed in your decisions, relationships, and priorities (see vv. 9-11)?
- 6. How do you see God producing the "fruit of righteousness" such as Spirit-led attitudes, God-honoring actions, and Christ-centered relationships (see vv. 9-11)?
