My personal application of this passage:

Questions for individual study, small group Bible studies, and LIFE Groups:

1. Do I fully appreciate my position in Christ? How does that motivate me to reproduce His life in my own? Have I truly committed to putting on His character (see 3:12)?
2. Am I consistently exercising the qualities in verse 12 with the members of my own family?
3. If I am being honest with myself, are there behaviors I need to “strip off” as I make the commitment to clothe myself in Christ’s character traits (see 3:8-9; 12)?
4. Is there some specific behavior or action that I am having trouble forgiving my spouse, my child, or my parents for? (see 3:13)?
5. Are my motives pure enough—seeking the highest good for others—to do what is necessary to help unify my family in the bond of love? Am I willing to set my pride aside and seek wise counsel (see 3:14)?
