

# Spotlight on Scripture Theatre Camp

## Daniel & the Lion's Den

Join us for our Spotlight on Scripture Theatre Camp, where we will create a short, a light-hearted retelling of Daniel & the Lion's Den. For ages 5-11, this fun-filled one week theatre camp will be less about putting on a Broadway caliber play, and more about engaging with scripture and bringing it to life!

Throughout the week students will be reminded of the Old Testament story of Daniel, while simultaneously learning the building blocks that make for great theatre such as: characterization, blocking, and projection. These theatrical building blocks will allow students to engage with the story of Daniel in a new way, and actually make him come alive!

Auditions will take place two weeks before camp starts on June 15<sup>th</sup> at 9am at Fellowship Bible Church. Campers that would like to be considered for a speaking role must attend auditions or send a video audition to the director.

The Daniel & the Lion's Den theatre camp is specifically designed for young actors, so there will be plenty of theatre games, breaks, and engaging activities. The week will culminate in a Showcase for parents at 2pm on Friday, July 3<sup>rd</sup>. So, join us for a week of theatrical learning and fun as we celebrate Daniel's faithfulness and courage!

**Auditions:** June 15<sup>th</sup> at Fellowship Bible Church at 9am. Campers that would like to be considered for a speaking role must come to auditions and be prepared to recite a short monologue, 15-30 seconds. Monologue can be a Bible verse, poem, straight monologue or even a song. Campers that would like a speaking role, but cannot attend auditions can send a video

audition to Dr. Everett. Campers that do not want to be considered for a speaking role do not need to audition.

**Showcase for Parents:** July 3rd, 2pm

**Food:** Parents must supply a sack lunch, water/drinks for the day, and a snack for each day of camp.

**Costumes:** Parents please help supply a Biblical costume for your child. Doesn't need to be extravagant!

**Memorizing Lines:** At auditions every camper will be sent home with a script. The cast list will be emailed to parents that night. Campers will have 2 weeks to memorize lines, and will be expected to show up to camp with their lines memorized.
