God in the Grain

Join us for our Spotlight on Scripture Theatre Camp, where we will create a light-hearted one-act play based on the book of Ruth, entitled “God in the Grain”. For ages 12-17, this fun-filled, fast-paced one-week theatre camp will be less about putting on a Broadway caliber play, and more about engaging with scripture and bringing it to life!

Throughout the week students will be reminded of the Old Testament story of Ruth, while simultaneously learning the building blocks that make for great theatre such as: characterization, blocking, and projection. These theatrical building blocks will allow students to engage with the story of Ruth in a new way, and actually make her, Boaz, Naomi and many others come alive!

Auditions will take place four weeks before camp starts on June 15th at 11am, and campers that would like to be considered for a speaking role must attend auditions or send a video audition to the director.

The one-week camp will culminate in a Show for parents and friends, at 2pm on Friday, July 17th. Teen actors are welcome to join us for a week of theatrical learning and fun as we celebrate Ruth and her tenacity to love God and love others!

Auditions: June 15th at Fellowship Bible Church at 11 am. Campers that would like to be considered for a speaking role must come to auditions, and be prepared to recite a short 15-30 second monologue. Monologues can be Bible verses, a poem, or a straight monologue. Many monologues for teens can be found free online. Campers that would like a speaking role, but cannot attend auditions can send a video audition to Dr. Everett. Campers that do not want to be considered for a speaking role do not need to audition.

Showcase for Parents: July 17th, 2pm

Food: Parents must supply a sack lunch, water/drinks for the day, and a snack for each day of camp.

Costumes: Parents please help supply a Biblical costume for your child. Doesn't need to be extravagant!

Memorizing Lines: At auditions every camper will be sent home with a script. The cast list will be emailed to parents 1-2 days after auditions. Campers will have 4 weeks to memorize lines, and will be expected to show up to camp with their lines fully memorized.
